- 1 Monday, fine Mercury about 86. Jimmie & Marv went to a town social at Martintown. Mirda and Muddy went to Hamiltons & to Knox church picnic of Lancaster
- 2 Marion did not come home last night she remained to visit Florence Ross. Mercury 92
- 3 Pic Nic at St. Raphael. Jimmie went. To stew 20 Not so hot about 80
- 4 Romans Meeting Bird gave 50¢ for offering for self and me. Boys put wire on fence between Kentail and Gibe Mercury 78.
- 5 Fine cool day. M. churned three times. This week and could not get butter. And the cream was very better. I called at Argubasto and got 50¢ of strawberries To 1 lb tea 25¢ He bought a horse rake of Saunders. It is second hand for \$15.00
- 6 Rain last night. Cool now 9 P.M. Raymond put in a pump in our cistern. Argubasto brought the berries. To sugar 50. Boiled 4 lb gooseberries. To 2 boxes put wire fence on the lane part of post office lot
- 7 John Robertson N.B. here to dinner. Heavy rain 2 P.M.
- 8 Bird washed. Bird & I called at Jimmie's To 3 boxes 15. 3 yds cotton 30 10 yds thread 15¢ changed at Willis. Muddy went in after noon to survey the road from Finner's bridge to Lancaster. Peter Robertson is with him. Brady of Lancaster put a piano there. until he can sell it. Jimmie cut some hay Jimmie had W. Ferguson working. To 2 boxes Pa got a pair of boots for himself 1.75
- 9 Fine day. a light shower in the morning. Baked in oven. Muddy had two men To 14 lbs sugar 100. 2 towels 30 To 1 lb tea 25¢

- 11 Thursday. Fine day. Jimmie put in two loads of hay on village farm W. F. by one day Baked some gooseberries
- 12 Pa's birth day, 87. he was working in the hay field. boy put in five loads of hay
- 13 Very fine day. To 4 1/2 lb steak 45
- 14 A large congregation Rd Graham preached
- 15 Jimmie alone at the hay. Hot
- 14 Very hot miserable 92.
- 17 Mrs Radnick by 1/2 day settled her half of rent up to 11th July. To 5 lb steak 50
- 18 Fine day not so hot. To 18 lb sugar at the Fair 1.00. Boys at the hay
- 19 Fine day. The boys have put in 24 loads Mrs Radnick M. Leman of Toronto, was here with Sandy Spire. Radnick is having a stone put to his fathers grave Bird was preserving black currants
- 20 Saturday Fine day our boys put in 28 loads and have some more to cut on the village farm. To 3 cans of salmon 45¢. Went Jimmie gates to Robertson to be repaired. Miss Brady Cook and Neddie Litch called for a short time
- 21 Very hot. I was not in church this morning. it's poorly. I was there
- 22 Fine harvest day.
- 23 Still at hay. Program in D. L. farm and Muddy went to work for Duman square M.C.
- 24 Jimmie got 1 doz eggs 19. 2 cans salmon 25 Mrs Brown sugar 25. at M. Cronin To 1 lb tea 25. Steak & sausage 50¢
- 25 Have Lavelle & boys return at hay
- 26 To 2 cans salmon 30 7 can beef 35 Finished hay on 2d lot. put in 24 loads
