went up to Mr Curries to day left
me a Box of Cigars when he came
Leander went up with them caught
a Lunge Rained to night 14th Fine Day
Corpus Christo Firing the Windows
Fernandez came from the Roads

James Cameron Island 15th June 1900
Fine Fernandez went to the Roads
Leander went to Mill 4 of Wheat
took Swan's Engineer to Stanley
Stanley Hoeing the corn mowing
grass for the Bull 16th Fine
Began the Battle of Waterloo
clabouring the North side NW
Stanley hoeing corn The Caterpillars
Busy in the Bush eating
the Leaves of the Trees Bugs
at the Potatoes Mosquitoes
Piling up Rubbish at the
yard fence 17th Corpus Christo
Fine Day East Wind Mr Lence here
Brought me a Channel Cat fish gave
him a good Bag of Potatoes some Eggs
some Butter lost his trawling line
Gordon here 18th The Ever Memorable
Battle of Waterloo Fine & Wind
put the plough through the potatoes
Leander to Jo Douguets with 2 Tubs of
Butter and 28 Doz of Eggs went to upper
point
