30. Murdy went to Alexandria with Far who is going to take the train for Ottawa. then to Sudbury. They went to Alick Peters. The childrens entertain ment was tonight. very cold. Mr Killop went with us and sang one of his songs. We had a telegraph from Murdy he will not be home tonight
31. To all tea 1/2 p. all coal oil at Duns. Paid 64
