Threshing outfit this AM got dinner here
Willie gave Tody cheque on R.B. for \$21.00 in full
50 for threshing. May gave Anderson boy from South
\$1.00 for F.A. renewal. PM Willie took 741
lbs chop to Wilsons Dan & Mand in wagon 43cts
brought up 300 lbs black dirt \$1.80 didnt get chop back
got oatmeal at Russells 25¢. I plowed No 4 PM
2 horses finished back what land. Jim Singer
in AM to see if Marshall Day had his bill for what
25 63 Raymond & Wilson up at night for figures got 4 paid 20¢.

Saturday

Very hard frost last night fine sunny day
I finished head land in No 6 also plowed in drain
in No 7 and last drain No 6 Willie down AM
got chop at Wilsons also bag shorts for \$1.40
took her to Arthur. PM Willie plowed No 1
4 horses I dug out drain we made through bush
25 from creek to tile. None of us down at night.

Hard frost last night fine day sunny &
cloudy. Mr Crow preached AM from
Matt 10:34 and in evening from Ephesians 1:7.
Mr Frodsham called PM. Gusch col 25 Mrs 25

Monday

A slight snow storm and rain last night blustery cold day
snowing & breezy got very frosty by night. We plowed in
No 1 4 horses. The drainers came back to-day Father son
and Murdy finished drain the ditch was on. I dug out
weeds of open ditch with drag fork and back filled
1642 22 drain. Willie chopped some horse.
