Mr Barbour got Punch and Peter Hamilton suds and Biscuit dish to work his mangel land with his horse, brought them back again at night I finished cultivating harrowing and rolling corn land A.M. and we sowed 14 more rows Golden Glow. P.M. I drove down town M and in buggy took harness to Mr J Smiths to get mended got pattern at Russells 2.05 spent church money, saw J.C.R about investing the state available \$1600.00 went to Bank decided to get war loans, I got at 7 & 8 1/2 bushel Whinnin No 7 corn I tared it when I got home. We sowed the rest of the S 3 then the W No 7 after tea 14 rows in all. Willie planted 3 rows potatoes No 2 Next farm at mangels P.M. A few mangels peeping through ground. I paid 78.20 for the corn and brought up crows May bought.

Sunny warm. We spread 5 small loads manure with team in N.D. and disked it A.M. Barbour got Punch A.M. Willie & Belle fixed up smoke house & put kams in. P.M. we finished disking small field below school also fixed a blocked drain in it. Willie planted 5 1/2 more rows potatoes in N.D. after tea. I drove up to Armstrongs at night took corn chiller up, looked like rain.
