I took some Mineral Chops to P. D. & brought home early Chops P. M. W. Sharp Strong NW wind a on fine & clear P. M. King's Birthday & Henry worked at Flavin's cow stable they are laying the floor with Bricks P & A drove 2 loads gravel from Collins a m into Barryard onto the stones that we put in I & A put over sheet iron on the bottom of our Feed Boilers P. Navy & Mary went to Markham P. M. I bring home the sheet iron from Cedar Grove A. M. P. Kennedy brought it from Toronto for us W. pretty cold a very strong West wind

Dunday 10 I & Mary went to Meeting at Altona remarks by C. Gayman Sermon on part of 19. C. St. Luke by C. Burkholder went to Ed Meyer to dinner A. Mary & Anne were at Meeting too W. rather cloudy sharp NW wind not strong about 22 above zero this morning fine & clear P. M. P. Henry helped Flavin at stable all day I showed & took Mary to Burrows he has a lump on her throat I think he has a lump last week they have all had the distemper now Mary Bonnie is running some at her nose but she does not cough any she travelled very well yesterday I mended some bags today W. cloudy drizzly at times heavy rain after dark getting quite mild

12 Henry helped Flavin A. M. A brought 50 Bricks from Cherrywood then called and took some lumber from here & helped at stables at Flavin's till night I brought home & ganged turning ground Henry helped Thomas in his hay pen P. M. he is rebuilding the inside of it I went to P. D. P. M. & picked some Dunlop Brooms Abram is using them for Asthma he can help to thresh some using them W. very strong W. wind turning cold & squally rain & sleet at times

13 I worked at Flavin's stable Henry helped Thomas went to Hermann A. M. & then went to Benji Thomas P. M. & bought 2 fat Turkeys I walked to Cedar Grove P. M. W. clear sharp strong NW wind a very little snow last night a few flakes today P. M. Mary helped M. Wright's thresh till about 4 o'clock & got home Billy shed I plowed the headlands in sod field & one in root field A. M. W. cold NW wind a m began to snow from NW after dinner snowed till night a few in on the ground P. M. Mary brought in bags potatoes out of the shed her into the cellar A. M. we cleaned bag oats P. M. I took 6 bag Mineral Chops to P. D. W. Mild strong NW wind some of the snow is thawing P. M.
