

October 1885

- 1 October came in cold and wet. We thought to take up the potatoes. But the rain stopped us. Ran & Marion got a bag full of butternuts on the Carlom's place
- 2 Rained all day. Ran got a bag of butternuts on uncle Murdy's place in the 4th
- 3 Began to snow 1/2 to 7 A.M. snowed for one hour
- 4 Was fine in forenoon. but began to rain about 3 P.M. rained all night. The Woman's Meeting was at G. Dingwall's R.R. I drove Harry & took Mrs W. Black, the bride. Flora McEamin, was there
- 5 I went for Birdie. The roads are very bad
- 6 A school meeting Birdie is to get the village school. All the teachers are to be changed. Far came home tonight and it is pouring rain
- 7 Dry today. Prayer Meeting in Hezebah tonight
- 8 At the potatoes Moorhouse brought us one wagon of potatoes. and 1/2 are rotten
- 9 Snowing all day dreary looking weather. we put up the new old stove we got it on Friday freight  
 got 1/2 gull coal oil 13. 1 qt vinegar 15. 1 boom 15.00 \$3.00  
 Willie Laroyne came to live in old Post Office for month
- 10 I painted the kitchen floor today we got the stove in good burning order. I did not go to prayer meeting. I feel very tired. I got a letter from Murdy. he is boarding at 49 chylm
- 11 A fine day snow disappearing. we took the potatoes on the other side of creek. by burn
- 12 Pa & Jennie & Ran. are trying to let the water off the potatoe patch at the village farm. Rented the farm house to Slick Collett. 2.50 pr month. Very fine until about 3 o'clock when it began to rain. We sent Murdy a letter last night with \$64.00 his fee is \$59. and books 64
