Snowing to-day. heavy in P.M. winter. We cleaned gran in A.M. In P.M. I went to Martha Dix's funeral in buggy. Paid J. Rafter for Bellmans service 12.00

Saturday

Sleighting again all over cold day sunny, thawing a little. I took down 9 bags chaff to Curless and 13  $\frac{3}{4}$  bushels oats @ 29 cts bushel \$4.03 chaff 45 and brought up 960 lbs coal for Mr Quarrie from Hamilton. Paid for weighing turnips April 10. In P.M. I took load ~~burns~~ wood down home and brought up chaff got at Armstrongs in afe graham flour 25. This cents 1 lb 9 got from Calahan for hay got 31st March \$2.00. Willie down town a night paid Willie for coal in full 8.08 received from him for hay delivered March 16 6.73 got at Phillips Bim & Co's bottle 75 post cards 5 with 8-
