- 23 did not finish packing. I made a cake today
of molasses, got 1 qt syrup 15^{cts} spice 3, brown sugar 50 68
2 lb granulated 22 1 lb raisins 10 - Birdie is at school, 32
Marion is at Mr Givens to tea, so is Larry & Murrel
It was very fine day about 5 P.M. it began
to cloud up for rain
- 24 Another fine day, Jimmie & Pa. went to Cor
nwall, left here about 10.30, drove Sable
I finished Muddy's pants, Far come home
with Pa & Jimmie.
- 25 Sunday, fine and warm, large congregati
- 26 I went to Lancaster and took Mrs Momo
with me, we were at the wooden mill
I got my yarn 12 3/4 lb. 14^{cts} per lb. Drove 1.79
to Depot, bot at Sandy's for Birdie 4 yds
cloth, 700 - 20 yds flannel 4.⁰⁰ 1 pair boots 3.50
trickery 75^{cts} - 6 yds Milton cloth 75^{cts} \$1.60 in all
bot for myself 1 pair red shoes 75, 1 hat 75 1.50
1 doz bread 42, 8 towels 80, The day was fine 1.22
- 27 Bot of Sandy McEntyre 8 lbs of beef, neck - 50^{cts} 40
6 squares washing blue 10^{cts} Another fine day 10
Ferguson (Thuriff's farmer) cut our oats
today 50^{cts} per acre = 2.50, boys at Lancaster
- 28, Paid Ferguson today Very fine day, the
boys put in two loads of oats, put Dolly
to pasture took Harry home Bird got
a hat at Mrs Gusty 35^{cts} ribbon 50 2.50
- 29 Fine day working at oats
- 30 Finished putting in the oats this day
- 31 Grand Lacrosse match between Young
Cornwall's and Union Glengarrans on
Williamstown Grounds. Glen, took 3
Three Straights, Bot of Fatigue 12 lb beef 1 -
Ken & Pa each 15^{cts} for gate money 30
10^{cts} to Muddy
