Misty morning cleared off fine. warm. William Sindall up all day plowing Willie cultivated No 4 W in A.M. Malcolm digging post holes all day. I worked at trimming posts. We took back load manure at noon. Jno Able got 30 bushels Bragration oats @ 40 cts \$12.00
 Girls down town in P.M. took 2 doz eggs to Russells 24 cts got cheese 15 cts and goods (see bill) ~~\$2.50~~ 12.50 nap at Fitzpatrick's travelling grip \$1.25
 Father brought up 3 apple trees in evening Willie drove him down with some cedar trees he dug up.

Thunder + Lightning last night and some rain cloudy am cleared off fine then thunder shower between 5 to 6 P.M. very warm. Wm Sindall up all day we took back load manure in morning and spread the pile back there In P.M. took back load there W.7. Took 10 days chop to Larkin and brought up load from steels. brought over load hay. I worked at fence we got corner post in. Malcolm Campbell digging post holes all day.
