Fine sunny A.M. dark clouds gathered P.M.
 thunder lightning and rain again a very wet time
 a bright rainbow seen in P.M. right close on
 fence of No 5 from house. We sawed the rest of
 the wood with engine in morning then Willie drove
 Mary around to Frodsham, Bays. Cass to collecting
 for Mrs Barbour's present which they presented her
 P.M. Willie took broken part of engine to Hodge for
 broken wiffletree to get mended. I got harness on tone
 boat and other things done. P.M. Willie drove down
 Punch in buggy got bag from P & L ^{P&L} m/c
 got Punch shot Hodge it and things mended w/60d paid
 ne got bread Simpons 18cts He drove along
 S.S. and changed places with me harrowing in
 No 6 at barn he ~~also~~ cultivated. I drove home
 got ready to plow at house orchard, was stopped
 by rain. Schars over got 1 bushel oats 55cts
 Mary got fish the other day 15cts. We drew engine into barn again

Mostly fine sunny. a slight shower P.M.
 Willie brought up father A.M. drove him down after
 tea. We cultivated harrowed and sowed the goose
 wheat next other barn fence and below the barn
 then some barley to G.S. and above barn. we sowed
 60 down with it. We treated the goose wheat with
 formalin. We use 3 horses on harrows and 3 on seeds
 PM.

Saturday

Fine sunny day. warm We used 2 3 horse teams
 got more barley sowed about 6 acres wheat and barley. Treated 2 bags
 barley with formalin sowed it between spruce tree

76654 and double cedar tree S.W. of spruce. I plowed home
