The glorious first of June Put the calves out in their
Pasture fixing their fence cleaning out up stairs cut some
Pine sent Gordon up for I Hopkins and then called
him back as I seen 2 men working at the Buoy
East Wind a good many on the Water to Day set
fire at the Brush Heap at the Bank and set fire at
the Wet Place Below the House Gordon fixing Log to draw
the Boat up on plastered a hole up stairs 2nd Gordon
started to go to Hopkins and turned back Isaac and John O'Connell
came to see the sheep picked out 4 of them the 2 Black
ones the one that lost her Lamb and the Biggest of last
years Lambs they said they would send to Dargast tomorrow
to shear them 3rd got a Basswood saw Lot cutting pine
Whitewashing the House 4th of mine of a George the 3rd
Birth Day shot in the sheep sheared ours
and marked the right ear all but one marked the Lambs
fixing some of the fence at the Wet Place kept in their
sheep and let bears go some Windy retained a little
5th Went around the Island got some pine spread a
succour looking at the sheep on the Pit Pitt
Point The Manitoba up first and then went and
Gowed a small Jug up from Below Charles Island
Tried to fish perch before the Door they wont
bite yet made a Round of growing got two Bites
Took a sheep in the Barn to Day the White hen
has out her chickens found the 2 pruned fork
that was lost since last fall in the stable loft
Windy to Day in spells a great many Boats went
up to Day Thunder Rain shot a Duck Ramelow to night
The Potatoes up some squashes up 6th Sunday fishing
he night 7th Rained some 8th Went to Dundee with 4
Sturgeon left 1 at home sold to Paro Bore a large one
got 50 cents out of R Bakers Store from Tins sold to B
that 30 cents sold 2 to Tins got 30 cents had 3 dozen Eggs
Bought 2 lb Tea 50 lb of Flour Matches got by Batching I forget Boring
Borden 1 Plug for hook dinner at Bills got my Bittles at Paro

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Our Marys Birth Day went to the Bush for Bark
Barked 2 chairs making the last of the soap 10th
Went to Squaw Island Charles Island Kops Island Lull
and Lizard Islands and to the Pit Pitt Island took dinner
on the East End of Kops Island seen a few Black Snakes
not many found lots of nests of Gull Island of the Gulls
lot some fat Pine I rowed all the way up and down
I did not get a Bite a lot of these dirty caterpillars
on those Islands now a fine Day East Wind 11th
10th Vipond came to shear the sheep sheared
his 4 and marked the right ear with a piece of took
his wool let out the sheep Weeding the Potatoes some
Gordon and Randolph fishing out before the Door
got 4 fishes Mina (Hares) 12th Jim Hopkins down
with the scow for the Bull Wind raised
very high Charlie Schumme and Georgina with
him Jim made a Paddle of an oak stave
Burned caterpillars Burnt the Horse shoes
Left the scow the Wind very high Jim started
had the Wind high croaking The Manitoba went
did not see the Canadian going up some Thunder
not much Rain a man and a girl killed at Lakin
with the Lightning to Day 13th Sunday Windy 14th
Cold 15th very fine went to the Board from the
Bush Relying Board in the Grove 16th cutting Weeds in
Potatoes filled the Bags with ashes 17th Went with the Wood
the Carding to Mr S. Mannings Will paid 20 cents him to send it
Bakers to Dundee got an order from R Baker to the Miller
Harrington for 100 lb of Flour 3 Dollars Live Robert the
dog 5 lb he will allow me what he gets for it Got 75
cents American money from him got 5 lb Tea on credit Bought
electric oil paid thus Bought 1 lb of Bordeau 1 plus 10 cents
