- 1 Thursday H. F. M. S. met there today
Church members including myself 25
My cold is pretty bad today
- 2 I spent a bad night. Got Thomas
Electric oil 25 - Comfito 10 35
- 3 Mrs Brown called and brought the
picture of Uncle Sandy's family
that she took from Toronto for me
I am some better of my cold
Jimmie went to Cornwall, drove hatty
he called at Michels. There is not
snow enough for runners yet
Jimmie got a black fur coat and
a coarse cloth one 10 20
- 4 Fine day. I was not in church
Mary Gore called. To did Lizzie 13
she has a new Russian Lamb jacket
with Russian table covers & roll up
- 5 Murdy left for North. Lochil, to be gone until
Saturday. Murdy to 2 loaves
- 6 Fine day. Jimmie went to Lancaster to see
the dentist. but did not see him. Daisy
took him all through the house
- 7 Snowing & blowing. To 4 loaves 24. 1 gall coal oil 44
- 8 Cold day. Sleights and Luggies, both on the
road To 2 chimneys 15 wick 5 20
- 9 Cold wet wind. I was out to the hen house
my first outing for a week. Jimmie emptied
Mrs Jones
- 10 Cold day Jimmie put up the worm racks
on the lower story of the big part of the
house. The others were put up over a month
To 100 lb opter hay from Dickhead & hind of it
ready cut up 5 1/2 ct per lb 5. 30
To pan bread 24. Murdy came after dark
Turned very cold
