Raining last night and this morning cleared off some then got very stormy and snowing PM not very frosty. We took 3 loads manure to pile AM. PM Wilkie and I went to Mrs Blackes funeral Mr Sars horse fell down in deep snow and stopped part of it we helped him get it out which made us so far behind we did not go down town. I cleaned seed barley and Wilkie put sharpened harrow teeth in Diamond harrow. Wilkie drove May down at night. He got lamp wick & its sockets.

Frosty sunny & cloudy stormy at times. Mr Green preached AM from Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors Matt 6:12. and in evening from Genesis 16: 7-9. I only down at night brought May up.

Monday

Very frosty morning cloudy and sunny cold.

Willie took 1080 lbs pig chop to mill paid 85 ct  
I day snow away from hearthboard windows and door.

PM I went to Elvira Dan and Kate in sleigh shipped 3 gasoline tbs to British American Oil Co  
4 35 at C.P.R. on way over took bag of tankage back to Ken's as it was poor & had pieces of wire stones etc in it got refunded \$3.25<sup>15m</sup> I ordered car tracks at Richardson's got ton of hydrated lime for land etc. Also got lime kiln \$3.50 went to Mill for chop and came home. Willie tried to start engine PM but failed.
