Mr. James Cameron Island June 30th
Friday Gordon and I took Pat down to Lancaster Gordon
Stopped at the Boat and went up to Mr
Harpers with Pat he gave me his over-
coat as he had no way of carrying it to the
West as he is going to start tomorrow
wrote a letter for Pat so I bid him
farewell and we parted for good and
I came home wind high 1st July morning
Day I then here for a while then I stopped at the
Lower Point I think its Mr Tilton one of them
2nd Fixing up old newspapers to bring to Mary
and Ellen in Williamstown 3rd started
for Dundee turned back 4th American Independence
Fishing over at Christies Island got a good many
to Rickel a great many boats on the
water celebrating 4th July John Hamilton took
away his Bull 5th Our Ohns Birth Day
Went for the Potlog Pot 6th Sunday 7th White Man
8th Henry Bosell here for Well Loads Bull
9th Went to Williamstown a very warm day
Angus out at the Caledonia Springs 10th in Williamstown
11th in Williamstown came home 3 Tunas to their to day
12th OT (Miss) Adams Day Went to Summerside for
the sea tobacco a Pleasure Trip the Atlantic and Bunshee
13th Went to Pops Island to look if it was a waste Kenneth
Cott was there 14th Raining making soap 15th Hamilton
and I Propellers a Race going up B. I. Baker here
16th Went to Summerside race beyond and
Went Big Bull a fight

Mr. James Cameron Island 21st July 1873
Morning a little 22nd Morning 23rd went over with the boat and
Went with a Passenger to Dundee a seller of some goods
24th Came home slept at Hopkins 25th High
Wind Mr Spencer and Mr Thompson a same man
and so been Rowing them picking Berries
up in the Bush 26th Took the Perchion
around the Head of the Island from below
the Bell Bay 27th Henry Bosell here and
one 26th Donald 28th Morning Killing in some 29th
Mr Spencer here Morning 30th William Roy here
I went to Summerside 31st went to Dundee
Got the Grindstone stopped at Hopkins
Coming back missed a great deal in the month
Ryan and White in the Barn to night 1st of
August Ryan and White here Raining very
hard turned fine and they started and was
caught in an awful shower it came down
Torrents 2nd Minnie's Birth Day 1864
3rd Sun Hopkins and some of the children here happy
to Mr Dougalls Boys here 4th Morning 5th Went
to Summerside Bought salt coarse and
fine 6th Randolphs Birth Day 1867 the
Boys went aground down near the Batterjet
Island took the Raft aground 7th Mr
here to night 7th Mr Spencer and I Fishing
a Party Fishing Fishing down on Charles Island
gave me a Fishing Tackle gave me a Dollar
I gave him a Paddle 8th Went to Dundee
9th Went to Charles Island missed on the Rmished
a Party come down 10th Sunday 11th Went with my spee
handle and prings to John Hopkins at Hopkings
12th Cropped the Rills from the Tit Tit Mr Tilton
here last night 13th Put in some hay taking care of the Raft
all this week as the Bos of the Raft sent a man to tell me
to look after it and they owe me 6/3 for cropping them
got their axe and auger for it
