Bella drove Father up to James Hamiltons to see about title of some land they have. Sold to Mrs McKee 270 lbs oats @ 1 ct. lb. \$2.70

Fine sunny day. cool. We hauled with spreader to wheat land 13 loads manure. I fixed fence between us and Fords through brush as three cattle got through we string barb wire along. Mary and Bella down town in P.M. got at Steels on after dress goods \$2.24 at 7 oots 10 ct vinegar Delimitin of Phillip 15
Mary gave two weeks ago \$1.00 for present to Miss Smellie who is going to Toronto to live.
