Marjorie went to church quite a bit out still the complaint
of people not coming out. Levi Dell went after the doctor
Drill Dells wife some better. the girls went to brick church
terribly rough roads my ducks walks a little better & they
at some better. I wrote to Jim & Marjorie wrote Mrs Buxer
Nov 18 Marjorie went to Cheffaw got Pauls boots
they were 2.95. had 4 1/4 butter @ 24 came in 102. 9 63 dust bill
7 2 22 du bill. sugar 25. lemon fruit 8. sarsaparilla 2
+ all 5 ginger 10. salmon 10 candy 25 match safe 10
tea 25 lemons 13 stock food 25 nails 4. I made a
grape pie. grape tart. 7 fried cakes. quite warm &
muddy. the paid Welland Mc Kingie for the cat bill 83.
Levi Dells wife died this morning had pork freshened & roast
I on 19 thunder wind west. mud pretty deep bushes &
cutting & fives maples. I went down & swept & dusted the
school house. Teddy went all the way Sam got & cared
of the boys & ran back. I churned & worked the butter
finished the fried cakes. Marjorie swept front room ^{day}
something her mother. Dell went on they took their horse

Wed 20 Feb Walmsley called & paid me for sweeping door of
Baxter & cleaning the schoolhouse. 1.50. my bill was 6.90 &
Paul. 1.90 the brought up Miss Hawley to visit the school
Miss Grey & I went over to bed to the other house. Tom Bell
came here for awhile then went to the other house gloomy
day wind east & mud mud every where. bushes went
to Port. for corn meal. rained on the night just poured
from the east. water ^{after we got home} ~~laying~~ all over
Thur 21 quite heavy thunder on the distance. Levi
Dells wife buried. the Bears lost hard on the horses
can hardly get along. Marjorie baked bread. I
made a layer cake & got some for the teachers dinner
& dressed a little black quill. for supper she was as
fat as butter. Com Sumnerville called on from the
funeral. a large funeral the church full Mrs Sanderson
preached the sermon one of the most dreary day I
ever saw just kept up a drizzle & dark & cloudy
towards night the wind raised to a gale something
deadful. from the south west.
Friday 22 another dismal day dark & gloomy but the
wind went down near night. Marjorie took the teacher
down at far as the bridge & Paul walked down with her
& came back with Ricey as he took 7 lbs of butter
& 24 paid it all on his boots but 30th 25 for sugar
& 5th for baking powder. I churned & worked the butter
there was 8 1/2. Clara Hecomes was married Wed 20
Sat a 23. dull & cold ground not froze though seal
muddy after the little shift of snow melts off & gets
colder towards night & freeze hard on the night
