28 I am almost done of the grunts, baked today P.M. Murdy fanning buckshot

29 Warm today, and the first night for mosquitos, in any quantity. They are appalling

30 Fine day Hatty came last evening Got 2 lb rice 10cts 3 lb sugar 20- 30  
Heard today that Mr John A was dead

From 29th September Jimmie Brown went for congregation yesterday. It began to rain. Murady & Brown came about noon, they were pretty wet. The games were for them. There was a Lucrose match between Coornwall mixed team and the Glens
