2 colts Paid 2 Dollars  
to turn Ploughing above the  
Oats in the upper field  
E Wind changed to West.  
Thunder commenced to rain  
Planted these carrots in  
the new garden Cherry w  
in Blossom and plum trees  
12<sup>th</sup> Rain cold W Wind hard  
Cropped got a letter from D  
Directed to Seander Seander and  
John went to Plum Island

James Cameron Island 13<sup>th</sup> May 1895  
Ploughing next the Bush cool  
Blowing Brush and Rubbish  
Planting seeds in the garden  
14<sup>th</sup> Working at the cellar dig  
it and making a way to come  
in from the outside. Set  
fres to the North side Marsh  
Back of the sugar Bush very  
Bad with Rheumatism Piling  
Stove wood pulling the ground in  
the Big cellar 15<sup>th</sup> Fine cool  
E Wind Tore Down the Mill  
Working at it water very  
Low 16<sup>th</sup> Frost Last night  
Fine some wind Working  
at the cellar Drew some  
stones to the Bank some  
grains of snow one of the cows  
calved to Day put the Pig in  
The Pen started the fence for  
the Pig Pasture  
Set the Mare out to Pasture  
The Seechy Guying Eye Hand  
17<sup>th</sup> Randolph came with the  
boat Paid him at the cellar  
7 rats at night
