line of horses was sent to day. Tonight  
Uncle Will and Aunt Maudie were here to  
put the wood down home with them.

13<sup>th</sup> Tue. Today Mother came out to Grandmal  
for me, yesterday Aunt Maudie Raymond  
and I took the Card home she had been  
staying to Grandmal, writing a few days.  
This afternoon Uncle John and Aunt Paul  
came out here did not know we were  
to Grandmal, we came home early  
and they went home I guess about 11.

14<sup>th</sup> Wed. Fine day. Father cut his wheat to-  
day. Mrs. John Mellow was here all day.
