- 4 went to Brockville with 3 Barrels of Snow Apples 1 Barrel I rolled every apple in paper it is to go to Glasgow the other 2 is for ~~my~~ Mr Robinson own use got 3 dollars & 12-6 each for the other two
- 5 went to John Younger with Jack Glen & Margaret on a visit Jack & me went to Kitley Fair fine day
- 6 helped John Ockland to thrash his wheat

- 10 helped John Ockland to thrash his oats
- 11 had a logging Bee on the Crested place got it fine job done firmed the most the heaps very dry & weather
- 12 worked at fire & logheaps
- 13 worked at the fire in the forenoon & began to draw in the corn the wind rose ~~to~~ very high & blew the fire into the stumps & into the old fences between Ockland & us & then into a crop Ockland & into Hoguen fence burned all the old <sup>stumps</sup>
