

- August 1 Ad went to help Wallace McNeil fine rain last night & the
rain morning this is the first day I have been able to be
out of bed since I got hurt with the Bull it was
only the mercy of God that I was not killed for when
I am very thankfull for his kindness to me
- 2 the Revd Mr Ferguson this evening there was no preacher this
morning there was a quarterly at the Union Church
- rain 3 Ad helped Wallace McNeil to do a little rain
- 4 As As As
- 5 Ad helped Bruce McNeil with his boating for day
- 6 Ad cut the piece that he left in the middle field
for Sod in the forenoon drew it in in the afternoon
Wallace McNeil helped him put it in the little meadow
I am not able to do any thing yet with the pain
in my neck & shoulders I cannot sit more than
hour or so at a time even drying weather
- 7 Ad cut round the corners of some of the fence
& drew the hay in put it in east half of the big
meadow
- 8 Ad cradled part of the oats at the old house
that is the first of our harvesting work day
- 9 Revd Mr Ferguson preached this morning Revd Mr
Matthews at night I am not able to go yet
- 10 Ad rigged up the reaper & drew in the oats that
he cut in Saturday Wallace & Bruce McNeil rigg'd
up a new Buck Eye reaper & tried here the afternoon
- 11 They cut in north east half of the north field
- 12 finished that part of the field then came &
cut part of the church field warm day
- 13 cut the wheat at the house & finished the
field at the church drew in load from the
North field Bruce Wallace & Trevor Sullivan
helped a very warm day the warmest we have had
drew in the oats of the church field had a load
drew in what was cut in the north field a load
it is in fine order the straw is as bright as it can be
- 14 Ad cut the rest of the oats in the field at
the old house they are a good crop there
