Ad cradled part of the oats at the old house that is the first of our harvesting work day

Revd Mr Ferguson preached this morning Revd Mr Matthews at night I am not able to go yet

Ad rized up the reaper & drew in the oats that he cut in Saturday Wallace & Bruce McKil rized up a new Buck Eye reaper & towed home this afternoon

they cut in north east half of the north field

12

finished that part of the field then came & cut part of the church field work day cut the wheat at the house & finished the field at the church drew in load from the north field Bruce Wallace & Brown Sullivan helped a very warm day the warmest we have had

drew in the oats of the church field had 6 loads <sup>Wallace & Brown helped</sup> drew in what was cut in the north field 6 loads it is in fine order the straw is as bright as it can be

Ad cut the rest of the oats in the field at the old house they are a good crop then
