April 4 continued Tuesday Forward 46880 23709

got very windy in P.M. and evening
I went down got load manure at Besse
got Dick and Scott's teeth filled with
Fred Armstrong's assistant brought over load
turnips. In P.M. Willie cultivated
in No 6, 3 horses and brought over load turnips.
Armstrongs brought up grass seed also bbl salt @ 1.35 m aft.

5 Wednesday

Frost last night - cool day cloudy and
sunny. I plowed head lands in No 6 then
Willie harrowed and cultivated in it.

We brought over from pit 2 loads turnips
the evening one to Mr. Mutch 45 bushels
at 10 cts @ 45⁰⁰. Bella and Mary down town

in P.M. took to Steels 5 1/2 doz eggs @ 13.71

got 6 table napkins @ 1.00 20 cts ranch at Memoirs

Mary gave collection W.F.M.S. 25 cts

6 Thursday

Frost last night cold windy day
cloudy and sunny. We hauled over
4 loads turnips from pit in A.M. and
in P.M. Willie cultivated in No 6 E
3 horses and brought over load turnips
at night. I cleaned seed grain. Willie
and Mary drove down for papers in evening.

7 Hard frost last night cold day strong wind
cloudy and sunny. We brought load manure
from Steels to T.L. took in rest of pit 4 loads one 30
bushels to T. Mills @ 10 @ 3.00 one to Behans 45 bushels

and two home. I bought calf from T. Mills @ 4.50
