Fine sunny day. We cut most of J.L. field to-day banner oats and stacked some. I scuffled turnips in A.M. with Jennie. Mary down home in evening Father came up with her.

Thursday

Fine sunny day. Willie finished J.L. field and cut rest of Waverley oats No 7 E in A.M. In P.M. he went down for chop 50 cts oil at Websters 18<sup>00</sup> boot mended 15<sup>00</sup> postage 2 then he cut six rounds in No 2 W. I finished stacking J.L. field to-day. Mother Auntie and Miss Burns up for tea.

Friday

~~Fine in A.M.~~ Cloudy day rained at night. Willie finished cutting No 2 W. I stacked up Waverley oats in A.M. In P.M. Father up he and Willie helped me stack more than half of No 2 W. Dong and Jim up in P.M. being made.

Saturday

Rained steady all last night. tremendous amount of rain fell. We cleaned chop in A.M. in P.M. Willie took it down to Curless and brought it back <sup>50</sup> also butter from Darris <sup>45</sup> Paid Dong \$1.00. I stacked some more in No 2 in P.M. got wet doing it. I went down town at night got from Fraser Fisher on hay \$8.00 Fine clear night moonlight.
