- 21<sup>st</sup> Sun. Fine day. This morning Father, Mother, Ethel and I drove back through the fields and came home around by 101. This afternoon I took my birds and I took up Father's mounted birds after tea, but I took to bed and stayed all night. Tonight I went to church alone. Next to go to take my birds back to my fields.
