

Dec 29 Maryon came home in the evening with from 7 apples
Will & Lill were down in Chippewa he got some chopping
done. I peeled the pears in preserve. Last night I
dined just as we were going to bed school 1/2 day
Wed 27 school all day I went for two days on account of convention
Maryon & Riet guarded the cows I churned & cooked the pears
Thurs 28 Will took a pig to Will's 10¢ for 1¢ weighed 130 then
he went to Chippewa in the fence about potatoes Maryon & Gordon
went after apples in W. Island got 4 bushels & 20¢ for bus
cold much wind Archie ploughing has the neuralgia on
his face one guarded the cows put them on the big fire
Friday 29. one year ago today Paul arrived from the north
west. Archie went after apples got 4 bushels I churned
the children guarded the cows. Maryon did not lend in go
in Hammondville but decided to wait until tomorrow
Entertainment at Hammondville Sunday school last night
the children went for wed night 27 got home wed 28
4 p.m.

Sat 30 Maryon went to Hammondville took 7 1/2 oz of adn left the
cows off 27¢ for 18 9 gal coal oil 18 lb tea 30 bag salt 10 lamp oil
7 lantern wick 4 lb soda 5 sugar 25 brown sugar 23 - lard 20
bowlings 23 thread 9 Pearl line 15 cheese 16 candy 2 sticks, children
took the cows out 1/2 9 sprinkled rain they put them on a 10
Gordon cut 4 sticks in 20 minutes I got them then dinner
I sent them with the cows they kept them until 2 o'clock
when we got the box over & they drew the apples over all but
the basket & the bag I took over. I made 2 pumpkin pies sweet
tooth sauce made 6 pots of mush. Archie finished the field
Sun 31. Beautiful day. The children went to the brick well
Hallie they walked. Paul home all day. Archie & Hattie
Squire church. the teacher went with them Maryon & Gordon guarded
the cows in the morning & the guarded at night the children got home at 4

November 1909
Sun 1. The most beautiful day you would wish to see
sunshiny & warm. bees out like summer. Archie ploughed
the potatoes out here by the house, after he got them out he
helped Will & one in pick up had to scrape the mud off with
a stick. had about 5 bushels for our pears got on the house until
12. Maryon & Marguerite guarded the cows, afternoon I churned
& washed the separates just before the cows were milked I had to
make 4 pots mush, out of cornmeal & middlings
Tue 2. Terrible day for wind the leaves came down more today
than all the fall, sprinkled rain at times not cold though
Maryon & Marguerite guarded the cows I washed separates & churn
made 3 pots of mush. I washed the room windows. Archie
started the big field in plough. they finished drawing in
their corn yesterday afternoon
Wed 3 fine weather for the time of year they guarded the cows
I picked the apple on Benz's lot in they would not choke
the cows after dinner they went to Houston & paid for the cotton
then went to the Greedie after vinegar but Mrs. Greedie was not
home. I churned. I got the barrel over for the potatoes & some
over getting a little colder.
Thurs 4 Will went to Chippewa Mrs. Brimmer called over & they
but I would have got all the potatoes over if I had not come
in the house I have to make 6 pots of mush a day for the
pigs Will brought Ethel's letter saying she was coming on
sat morning Maryon set spruce at night
Friday 5 Marguerite washed the cows while Maryon tended in her
bread. she washed the curtains over & starched & ironed them &
washed the room we got the bedroom bureau out on the kitchen
& the front room then out so I could black it & the pipes
at night I peeled a lot of apple & cleaned a lot of rations
most beautiful day
