Fri Sept 29. Fine and quite warm. made Christmas Cake Started to tie up yonge st at Thornhill Donald hurt his arm. Elizabeth came to mothers for a week. very dusty. called on Mrs Shuter.

Sat Sept 30. Fine and warm. Auntie and I at grave yard in the evening. Annie and Lizzie here in eve.
