- 27 Marion left for Lancaster to take the Mocas on tomorrow morning for Montreal gave her \$9.00
- 28 To 4 lbs butter 1.00 1 gall. coal oil 20 2 loaves 10 1.30
- 29 Far came with a mare and colt that he bot at Lutch's sale To sugar 25 To 3/2 lbs steak charged at M. Intyres 15
- 30 Fine day, a good many in church. My off 10.00
- 31 Marion did not get back yet Mundy left for some place On the 27 Jimie bot at Patneff Lancaster 1 bag of potatoes 1.50 per bag. Birdie come down Mundy finished planting the potatoes Paid milk 1.00

- 9 Fine cool day a large congregation my off 10
- 10 Marion left in evening to go to Montreal tomorrow I drew \$15.00 from F bank. gave her \$10.00
- 11 Jimie went to Montreal today far will be married this evening to Miss Jean Elizabeth Scherer Oman To 100 of flour 3.60 - 2 lbs butter 57 1 lb tea 96 4.95
- 12 four loaves 25 not paid
- 13 Marion & Jimie got home on the truck to home
- 14 Looks like rain Mundy went Glen Roberts To 2 loaves and paid for the 4 got on 8th 36
- 15 No rain
- 16 Fine dry misquitos had got To 5 lbs steak charged To butter 90 cts sugar 25 dried apples 25 1 fine apple 13
- 17 Fine in morning rain in afternoon My off 25^{cts}
- 18 Cool Marion cleaning sitting room
- 19 High wind
- 20 Looks like rain cleaning dining room
- 21 Rain today J. Kobutson called To 4 loaves charged
- 22 Bot 4 lbs butter 1.00 sugar 25 1.25
- 23 2 lbs cheese 15-30 2 lbs bacon 37 rooled oats 25 9.2
- 24 1 gall coal oil 20 2 lbs lard 36
- 25 o roast at M. Intyres charged, 2 fine apples 26 8.1
- 26 Far and wife came in evening We are having communion tomorrow, had Kate preached today My off 10 Cold today a pint of milk 3 13
- 27 Fine day Betty large congregation off for French do. and Augmentation My off 1.00
