Mr Barbour over this AM helping with manure
 We got 4 loads out from pig pen & yard and 4 from
 pile in No 2. PM we got one load out from pig
 pen and 13 from pile finished manuring corn land
 once. Willi took wool to station 129 lbs and
 13 lbs pulled fleece & tags also cream to station.
 he paid 38 cts freight on wool (got at Dunlakes
 shore 45 cts land side ^{returned 19th} 40 cts) bolts 9 cts alum at
 Phillips 5 cts. I fixed up gaps in No 5 lane fence
 We plowed some in horse orchard at night.

18 Friday

Mostly fine day, warm, sunny. We plowed
 in No 2 2 furrow plow 4 horses took long
 time to clean. R. Hannah brought load hay
 P.M. got tea here we paid him \$9.00 we took about
 100 lbs of it over to Lass I went with him. I drove
 down at night got stamps for Dr Annersville
 letter at J. Beathis 3 cts went to J.C. Richardson
 signed cheques for Hy estate accounts. I left
 Mend along home she was very lame.

Fine sunny with passing thunder storms one
 at noon and a terrific one between 5 & 6 P.M.

1075 cloud burst of rain. warm. good growth today. Melville
 Hill drove & cattle Barrie. Burnie cad. Quince 2nd lane one
 Jakes red 3rd. Vals. Red aton Red & Rose Victoria & Quince. Patten one
 up on road to Hannahs Willi drove up after with hay they got back after
 12. I plowed No 2 4 horses AM. PM we plowed with team eye
 plow & Melville harnessed 3 horses. paid M.H. \$1.00. Fancit got load of order. Barlow over
 at night went down road with Will who went down town with Punch. Reves smith 1479
