leg & G had turnip I cut road around Spring Wheat P m
Sunday 28 I & Nancy & boys went to Meeting at Altone sermons by R D Hoover sermon on St Luke 20 C by B C went to Simon Hoover's P m. & to G Burkholder's at supper W. fine clear. Cool
29 Cut bound & shocked Poor Land wheat south of old bush. W. Cloudy, drizzly this evening
30 G & boys had & I suffered turnips AM Cut Poor Land wheat below garden P m W. Cloudy AM, drizzly this evening
31 I & boy John & I having went to Muskham & G had turnip AM bound & nearly shocked last of Poor Land wheat till supper heavy rain after supper, very wet time
August 1 G had turnip I cradled road around field wheat back of graveyard & he bound till noon Then we cut last of Poor Land wheat east of Orchard till about 4 P m then a heavy rain & thunder shower came up lightning struck Henry Boyer's beam & burnt it with his key & body
2 G cut road around Oats & shocked some wheat AM I drew load of hay for H Store, very wet. Finished cutting Spring wheat & 5 rounds of Oats John drives the reaper. has coil on his hand
3 I cut Oats AM. John's hand very sore. G bound Spring wheat. John drove PM coil broke I & G bound Oats P m. W. pretty warm
Sunday 4 all went to Meeting at Cedar Green sermons by B C sermon on by R D Hoover JDs were here P m W. heavy rain P m pretty warm

began binding ^{Aug.} Spring wheat about 10. am finished at supper. Then set machine W. Cloudy & G shocked Oats till about 2 past rain then he drew wife boy & me asked hands to thresh. Threshed m. about 180 bus Clawson wheat, pretty good sample. W. rain this morning. Shower at noon. Clear P m
G helped D Hoover thresh I & boys drew loads hay P m. W. windy. Clear girls went funeral of Michael Burkholder's child P m & Nancy went to Henry Boyer's after supper G bound Oats I & boys drew 11 loads Spring wheat. W. warm. Strong wind P m
all finished drawing Spring wheat 12 loads W stacked hay behind Cider house 12 loads ^{W. Clear} W. Clear
Sunday 11 all went to Meeting at Hebron. sermons R D Hoover sermon on St Luke 17 C by B Burkholder's girls & Nancy, Brother's Cross & Jesse were here P m. I shook Burkholder's at supper I & boys bound Oats G helped M Dyke thresh fine Cloudy nearly all day
I & Nancy went to Toronto sold Lamb's @ \$7.75 for head. Butter 22^{lb} eggs 16^{lb} boys bound Oats G sped M Dyke Thresh AM helped boys P m W. warm
Finished binding & shocking Oats till supper G shed headland of Peas after supper W. Clear & boy drew 7 load Oats G helped ^{showed} B C Thresh ^{put before supper} trying Cut the pupil of his right eye open with end of his knife handle trimming a switch of Willow about 4 P m. I took him to Dr Robinson advised bathing with cold water. W. fine drew 8 loads Oats. W. warm very heavy storm thunder & lightning north heavy rain here about 2 past 6 P m.
G & boys cut Barro & had turnip I got cell & Frank shod P m. heard about 1 or 2 fires in Whitechurch burned by lightning last night. Dr was here this evening advised taking journey to Eye Doctor in Toronto on Monday W. fine. Creeks very high
