75 Got 2 Cabbage Heads 5 M Shet

Fine W Wind sawing stove wood Leander
and Livinia came turned to East
10th Fine Mr Tye High E Wind
Rained hard Ploughed some put
few Loads of stones on the Bank
B Day 11th Unfortunate Day Windy
Raining Leander shot a crane
water is low a few ducks not
many not very well W Wind
12th Fine Rained some set the
2 pigs out of the Pen Ploughed
some on the Lower Point taking
out stones putting them around
the shore Broke the stone boat
put the Late Tobacco 13th Rained
all Day Livinia not very well
Gordon came had the Mail
a letter for me from Bismarck
British Columbia and a letter
for Fernandez from Lisbon
Center N Y 14th Windy Randolph
came took his leather coat Gordon
crossed Leander to Cat Island
15th Snow on the Mountains Cool
Windy drew some stones to the Bank
Ploughed a little on the Hill
ploughed some of the Potatoes
gave Lucias 1/2 Bushel of
Potatoes Sunday Put in
one of the Rigs
