- 1 Monday. May St Thomas was married this morning, to Manor. Very fine day Jimmie went to Glenis with D. M. Robertson Murdy is off somewhere. Keeping Dominion Day
- 2 Ann Hall 1/2 day 30^{cts} A m^d milked.
- 3 2 loaves 12
- 4 W. & M. I met in vestry. I paid 75^{cts} for three month. And 10 for my part of Express 2 loaves 12. I tacked an old comforter
- 5 Lawn social on High School grounds. I made two cakes for it - Ann Hall 1/2 day 35^{cts} she washed the outside of windows and ironed a few clothes (from galopsey) 2 loaves 12 Very hot - mercury up to 92
- 6 8.30 A.M. Hot 70 2 loaves 12 1 gall. cut oil chum 12
- 7 Hot mercury up to 94. I did not go to church sent off 25
- 8 I put heliobore on current bushes washed a few things Mercury up at noon to 92
- 9 Hot 84 at L.P.M. sent letter to Marion Van from Cornwall called
- 10 Murdy left for Prescott. Lent him \$5.00
- 11 70 100 for 1.45 - 2 loaves 12
- 12 Fine day. Murdy came home last evening. Left today for North Lancaster
- 13 Ann Hall 1/2 day 35^{cts} Far came in evening To bread 24 Sold 3 1/2 doz eggs 25
- 14 Sent my off to church 25
- 15 Murdy left for Cornwall, Jimmie to Mrs James Fraser's funeral. Led Con Lancaster
- 16 Ann Hall 6 1/2 hours 40^{cts} Murdy came in evening and Dixon who is running the line for the new R.R. from Cornwall to C.P.R. at Delhousie or St Polycarpe. They had tea and went back to Cornwall.

- 21 Borrowed 25 for offering. Lave Jimmie 72
- 22 Far, Jean and Miss Dora Amen came and spent the day. Bot on Saturday at Mc Grummo 1 can Salmon 25 25^{cts} Sweet biscuits 35 lemon 10 sugar 1⁰⁰ 1-45
- 23 2 loaves 12 4 lbs Butter from factory
- 24 Bot a book from a Miss Mc Millin 50 50
- 25 2 loaves 12
- 26 Sent an order to Simpsons for 3⁰⁰ Gave Jimmie \$5⁰⁰ Order 3. postal note and postage 5 - total 3.05. Gave him the ballance 1.95
- 27 2 loaves. paid Murdy for 2 gal on 25 - 24 24
- 30 Ann Hall 1/2 day 35 2 loaves 12 37
