Snowing a lot to-day stormy and drifting snowing least night frosty. I at home & M. also Bella. Mr. Crow preached A M from 2 Peter 1 and 21 a sermon on inspiration of the bible, not many out, Mr. M. Kay of Eramosa preached at night from Psalm 105, 21 & 22. Willie waited for me in evening we both drove up in buggy snow deep enough for sleighing. Ch coll 25 Miss 25 girls. Bella wrote a letter to J S Ross about uncle Jim having a cold.

Monday

Frosty winter day sunny & cloudy sleighing thawing some in sunshine. Snowing some. I brought sleigh over from other barn and Willie took 22 potatoes down to Adam Armstrong. 132 lbs @ 14 cts \$18.42 got due bill he brought up load manure from Jno Quinn we put it at end of shop house root house. I put implements in shed 50 etc. P M we mended barn floor at big doors on wide thrashing floor used 6 planks we got from J. Baker Willie chopped horse.

Cloudy not very frosty, soft snowing at times Charlie Quinn came in with team in sleigh for some hay but we did not give him any I cut wood in hole back. The drummers came back this A M drove in buggy. P M they got a drain done up half way across No 3 from culvert 5 in tiles up to first lateral West of the one we had in then 4 in. There was a little sunshine to-day We played some on auto harp in evening.
