Sharp Sleighs are running yet  
our good Queen Victoria is reported  
very low and not expected to live

class wood at Flavin's P M B C  
called A M Joking Reaser & N B  
called P M Nancy sat up in bed  
awhile P M A B Lissie called  
P M W. Clear & Sharp the soft  
snow fixed up the sleighing pretty well  
pretty cold
