Management of Surgical Cases—No. 1.

After abdominal operations patients should be careful not to strain a fresh scar by over-exertion or coughing, and in drainage cases one must be on the watch to prevent obstruction, by care in diet and the judicious use of cathartics.

Most persons during the post-operative stage eat too much and suffer from digestive disturbances in consequence. Asa-fetida is often helpful in these cases and also in nervous complications.—Leigh; Int. Journ. of Surg.
