morning, got Father's pants, etc. 213  
woolskin to face with, 37, snaps 37  
05, sold 2 ton straw to W  
Hammer for Fat Stock show  
at \$5.50 per ton, 550

Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> fair & cold  
Father & C.R. finished Shingling  
woodshed. I went to town got  
2 square shingles at Clemens  
Father & I went to Church  
~~at 9:00~~ I went to see W.P. Hammer  
about getting manure from the show  
we are to be in by eight o'clock  
and clean up satisfactory  
to market clerk.

Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> fair  
C.R. & Father choring and  
fixing up yard generally  
& J. & I finished potatoes &  
started taking in wood  
I went to town for W.P. Heather  
to fix raven trough. Also  
took Mary & Children in to  
get their pictures taken  
we are to get 9.25 paid 250  
also Mary got other things  
# Gave Mary \$1.25 hardware 30<sup>c</sup> 125
