- 14 Warm day. our boys are very much taken up with the coming election
- 15 Another fine day. W. Corinmon gave me a cheque on the Merchants Bank for \$15.00 To 4 loaves
- 16 Lovely day Jimmie got my cheque cashed gave \$7 to Mundy for money borrowed for Mueldeke and 85 for bread and rooled oats. For the oats To 1 gall coal oil 20 pepper 10 cinnamon 10 All office 5. 4 loaves yesterday 24

- 17 Lovely day To 6 loaves 36 fed gar 10<sup>cts</sup> 1 lb tea 35
- 18 Monday paid Jimmie \$4.00 for rent John McGillis formerly of Williamsstown will be buried here tomorrow. McGregor the Cove, Candidate has a meeting here tonight
- 19 Fine day, just like summer. Rev Kenneth MacDon who is visiting his brother. preached in St. Andrew's Hall the 5<sup>th</sup> Sabbath. My off 25 - 5 to Kate I was down to Robertsons to supper. Met Mrs Thompson John R McDonald, P.L.S. daughter I had not see her since she was a child, then we went to the political meeting John McGillis was buried.

- 26 Rain last night. and rain today. I was not in church sent my off 15 John Christie and wife came about 2 P.M. remained until after tea
- 27 Rained through the night and showered all day. The Polling took place at Duncan MacLarim house. for election of member of Federal House
