Coligny to get her glasses & Reels, dryed most of the forenoon  
I flacked the floor swept the rooms made a cake a grape  
pie & grape ears, killed a chicken & dressed it for supper  
Marguerite got her new shoes 150, Arthur took up one pair of shoes  
had only enough for one meal but it was the last swarm here.  
Sun 17 dull at times & sometimes wads heavy fine Piecing all day  
Fannie marshalled in the other house for dinner & supper they went  
in the truck Arthur took them

Sun 18. Fine Piecing & Kates birthday. Gordon started to school  
I churned & worked the butter washed a basket of tomatoes & peeled  
them for chills sauce. Marg made me Reels blue pumpers. Arthur  
took up another pair of shoes with a more than the other they took  
them up with the double swarm on it it was full. Hattie over  
Sun 19. storm wind most of the day but sometimes. Gordon helped  
Marguerite with the cows until 11 then Marg had the bread  
mixed & she went & helped Marguerite until 11. took one all day  
forenoon cleaning up around the house every thing to do. I made  
made a big jar of chills sauce & washed some of my underwear  
Marguerite baked the bread finished the pumpers. I boiled some  
wheat for the pigs till up in the evening after a plough then  
Wed 20 most beautiful day Marguerite & Reel guarded cows  
until 14 & 12. I washed a lot of white clothes & boiled them  
sun bright but a cold north wind I was going to churn  
when Kati Piecing came on. Hattie was down in the Chippawa getting  
this year set. Marguerite & Gordon took the cows out after school  
Hattie 21. rained most of the night not hard for shoes not much  
water caught, could not guard the cows in the forenoon for it  
is drizzling. Gordon took them down in the pasture then he  
went to school then after dinner Marguerite & Gordon took them  
out until 4 when a thunder storm & rain came up I churned

just got through when the storm came hard just poured & the  
wind blew hard at night poured again. Hattie & Arthur were  
going to Taft to practice. I churned this forenoon for ourselves  
Arthur ploughing by their house

Friday 22 Marguerite & Marguerite guarded the cows until eleven  
I measured up 2 bushels of wheat & a bushel of oats. he took  
in Chippawa to get shipped for the pigs took 3. <sup>4</sup>/<sub>13</sub> of 89. eggs  
sugar 25. tea 15 soap 5. Ginger 10. Lard 10. Marguerite & Arthur  
paid 411 out of the ducks & Marg paid 24. Cheese 14. Hattie killed  
a pig for themselves. the roads dreadful. I churned & worked the  
butter washed the churn the got 2 little pumpkins & Marguerite  
gave. Arthur took Marguerite 2 hives of bees up started to rain  
I poured at one time. Arthur dug a mess of potatoes for Reel  
them for supper & the liver they gave had a good supper  
when the came home

Sat 23. Miss Barrow & Della Miller in the other house got there at noon  
Marguerite started in Chippawa to go over the river Fannie got the 2  
of butter 230 went on Sun in Thorold after flannel got 24. 2.  
I yarn 30. got 30. at the descent store 25. & sweet potatoes  
did not come home until 9 o'clock. I made 4 pies  
out of pumpkin one for the children for sewing wood &  
small sponge cakes. rained some at 7 just as I was  
Sun 24. The children went to church in the morning in the  
other house for dinner. Levi Well beared this afternoon  
the children went. I was here all day alone. cold  
day & dull until nearly 4 o'clock when the sun struck  
out freezing all the afternoon wind north & brought  
froge over before night. coldest night yet ground  
froze like winter almost. Tom in the evening at the other house  
Sun 25 Miss Barrow & Della went home & thanked giving day  
once sunshine most of the day had 2 pumpkins for dinner  
I churned & washed the butter had to boil 6 pots & cracked
