January Saturday 1 1927

Rocco and I had our first cattle ride of the season when he went up home and I went after Jean and took her up too. My feet were pretty sore so I hired Lloyd Ross to stay out of school and help me peddle the milk. Bought new pair of shoes and got a pair of arch supports at Geo. I. Keaters.
