19 Cart loads F & H drew dung W. strong
east wind rained about half hour about
4 Pm cleared up again I went to A B
with Stouffer & then took him to
Merris River & left him there
14 Boys Plowed I & J filled up grit at
other barn H took it to B & Dr Parr
Spraggis began to lath upstairs at
house at other place. W. fine
15 Boys Plowed A Picked grapes &
apples I sold Cord Hard wood to
C Smith's son @ \$3.50 W. very
fine & warm. saw flock wild geese

16 Boys Plowed I & H brought load
Sand from Milnes & brought home
Chop W. fine warm Am began to
rain about 2 Pm rained yet
17 H helped B & Dr finish other boys finish
ed plowing N E Corner field & then
finished field east of dam where we
drew dung for Mangels next year
W. fine & Clear
18 A & Henry brought 1 1/2 Uels lime
from Mark Run I & J drew some
wood Am then I & A ran lime
Mary Susanna & Henry went to
John Stovers I & J went to
D Brownberger's Dale at Solomon
Burr R Hole's Pm W. fine & warm
H helped B & Dr finish thirking
Sunday 19 all went to Meeting at Helton
except Susanna Anne & H remarks &
Jenison on St John Mc C by B. C
W. rain rain from N E all day
raining yet at Bed time
20 Three boys Plowed in Wheat stable
at other place I brought Burrows
