got the mail & the Budget Speech

fine putting in the stable
loft and the barn raking
gathering all cleared of the
south side put in from
back of the barn Martin
here for butter 12th Orangan
day fine put in loads of hay
back of the barn raking lots of
smoke big fires some where
a few drops of rain
Mary Ann here Lewis wife
Flour Butter out Leander for mail

James Cameron Island 13th July 1895
Fine Barnhart at the head of
the island looking for a Ducquet
Bless morning Rullung
14th fine John H. West to
Dundee took a cabbie
with him 15th fortunate day
cutting hay putting in making
coils ^{St Swithins Day} fishing in making coals
Killed a mutton and two
a good one & wind John H.
came 16th fine cloudy some
drops of rain made some coals
mowing Lewis here gave him
the sheep's head butter and
milk salt Mrs McLeod's
barns stables and hay burnt
yesterday night so fence here
y night and Shora the Blacksmith
using the Buoy at Francis Is.
drilling a hole in a stone at our
island Raining some tonight
Lower field all cut
