455 Raining some this morning turned to sun thawish day cloudy. We worked at making a pullet house in South corner of sheep house. Willie drove girls down town P.M. Mary stayed down they got at Russells goods on 1 00 4.15 at Woods goods 3.50 at Phillips colanders etc 60 ¢ Willie returned the stove bricks which cost 90 ¢ to Mrs and got charcoal 25 ¢ and stove pipe 10 ¢ in part payment he also got at Morris mens 50 ¢ harness mended at Womers 25 ¢. Mr James Temple here P.M. to see if we had any young pigs to sell.
