 Hokey Corn Digging Tobacco Perce  
 1<sup>st</sup> July Cumtton of Mr Randolph Blood  
 Leander went to Squaw Island Bullemur  
 for a Gunny or Ric milk on the 2 Islands Centner  
 and Wife 2d Jessima and Wife Miss Robudau  
 and another and 2 children made a Ric milk  
 in the above Hokey with the Pedro  
 1<sup>st</sup> July Spin went across the River  
 Married a Great Time all over  
 Great Boat Race over
