In the past, hemorrhage or pressure symptoms have generally been the reason for removing uterine fibroids. In a few rare instances gangrene of the tumors has necessitated their removal. More recent microscopical examinations of large fibroids have proved that about five per cent. have undergone sarcomatous degeneration or carcinoma has developed in or about them.
