Tue Apr 9th clear and warm. I was spreading the cattle droppings. Walter started to plow the ground so wet he had to quit

Wed Apr 10th clear and hot. the thermometer 75 in the shade. Dickie and I finished spreading cow droppings this fore noon. I was digging in the garden. & Dick went for his Books this after noon. Walter was rolling the meadow

Thu April 11th cloudy after noon wet. Walter finished rolling the meadow ground commenced to plow rain stop him. I and Dickie was leveling the ground that the pigs dug up in the orchard.

Fri April 12th rain last night and most of the day. the ground soaked with water. I was letting off water when it was not raining

Sat. April 13th clear. high cold raw wind from the North. the ground has dried very fast to day. I was deepning the ditch between me and Whitker Bilton at the North West corner of the farm. Walter was helping Ira Brock move their household furniture over to the Season farm.

Sun April 14th clear. cold wind from the North

Mon April 15th clear. Wind from the east and cool. I was ditching. the boys repairing fence

Tue April 16th clear and pleasant. I was ditching. Walter commenced plowing again the ground wet
