commenced to Day to go to Isipere
Island for Wood 2 Teams and
2 on skates 2 of our Boys went
to Dundee Heard a man was
caught with high Water at Bombay
and Lost his Horse caught some Pike
13th Raining one of Lewis's Boys for
2 inch Aeger Fernandez went
across high high Wind this Evening
Windy Windy to night
