15 Monday. Very cold. Walter killed a cattle beast for Enoch Schneider this morning and cut it up this afternoon. Ella did the washing and crowing. Called Enoch & Irvin Schneider, Isaiah Bauman, Joe Singrich, Mr. Ferguson (a farmer of Cumrook, not the Honorable G. Howard)

Ed. Daum of Kitchener accidentally shot himself in the leg while hunting rabbits on Saturday at Heidelberg and died next day.
