Cooky came with his thrashing outfit PM he & Pat Barbour put in PM fitting it up they got tea here Oliver Ireland here for dinner came to see about the mortgage on Smellie property he has purchased. Mr Barbour over at night Willie down town at night to see about hands for thrashing etc. got bread 12 5 got this AM fly paper 5 to provide trial Mitchell
