Mary drove down town took father down he was up for dinner then she brought up Sophia ~~Spence~~ Newton from hospital to stay here a while. Mary got at Armstrongs groceries etc 90 sold 5 doz eggs at 16 cts doz 80 cts got from Mrs Wilson for butter \$2.00 Mrs Mc Vicar 68 from Mary Mutch 1 doz eggs 15 salts 5 Willie worked turnip land before tea then after tea we drilled up 13 and sowed 3 drills. Joe Indale for Black and I at culvert on Gordon St to see about putting in cement one. It was washed out last weeks rain flood postage²
